WELCOME TO CAMP WASSATOGA YOUTH CAMP

Thank you for wanting to utilize the facilities and activities of Camp Wassatoga Youth Camp. Our goal is to provide your youth organization with an assortment of outdoor activities that will provide recreation, education, and leadership opportunities. This Registration Agreement will guide you through the process of securing our camp for your activities by providing mutual understanding and expectations.

YOUTH RELATED ACTIVITIES

Camp Wassatoga Youth Camp is available for youth and youth-supporting activities under our lease agreement with the Effingham Water Authority. Youth activities are easy to define as those activities that involve youth (e.g., camping, canoeing, volleyball, etc.). Youth-supporting activities are those activities that involve adults in a way that supports planned youth activities. These activities could include adults going through canoe certification training using the lodge for classroom training and the canoes and lakefront for hands-on training. Because this training is to support youth activities it is permissible.

PROOF OF INSURANCE AND LIABILITY WAIVER

Camp Wassatoga Youth Camp provide an opportunity for youth organizations to have an ideal location for outdoor activities. However, with any outdoor program there are physical risks involved. For this reason, our insurance provider requires that we only authorize organizations that meet the following criteria:

- Must complete and sign the Group Liability Waiver Form with this signed Registration Agreement.
- Must provide a certificate from your organization's insurance carrier in form and substance and from a carrier reasonably acceptable to Friends of Camp Wassatoga 30 days prior to your group's arrival date stated on this Registration Agreement. The insurance certificate must state that this organization is insured under a comprehensive general liability policy with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence \$2,000,000 per aggregate and that Friends of Camp Wassatoga is named as an additional insured on such policy of insurance. In addition, a copy of the endorsement shall be provided. Receipt of the foregoing is a condition to the Group's use of the Facilities.

PETS / SERVICE ANIMALS

Due to risk of injuries, NO pets are allowed at Camp Wassatoga Youth Camp. The only exception is Trained and Certified Service Animals, which are allowed according to federal law. Proof of training and certification may be requested by staff of Friends of Camp Wassatoga if a Service Animal is reportedly behaving in a manner that is a danger to the safety of others.

1. The lessee is renting the above checked equipment.

Group Liability Waiver

This agreement is made by and between Friends of Camp Wassatoga, a nonprofit corporation, and the Rental Applicant Group/Organization "Group" _____.

Rental Fee and Payments

The Group agrees to pay all Rental Fees, deposits, and balances in accordance with all Friends of Camp Wassatoga Rental payment policies and deadlines.

Camp Rules

- The Group agrees to comply with all of Friends of Camp Wassatoga Use Rules ("Rules") and shall cause all persons with the Group's permission or by invitation from the Group or any Group member (collectively "Permissive Users") to comply with the Rules. The Rules have been or shall be provided to the Group on or before the Group Leader's arrival at the Camp Facilities and are incorporated herein. The Group and its members shall be responsible for any noncompliance with the Rules by the Group, its members, or Permissive Users.
- Failure to comply with the rules may result in an immediate termination of the Group's right to use the Facilities; any and all fees paid are non-refundable upon any such termination. The Group agrees to assemble its members and all Permissive Users for a brief orientation session to be conducted by the On-Site Rental Coordinator(s) ("OSRC") on camp procedures and the Rules; provided that any failure by Friends of Camp Wassatoga or the OSRC to provide such orientation sessions shall not relieve the Group and its members from their obligations under this agreement.

Camp Condition

- The Group shall walk through the Facilities with the OSRC upon arrival at and departure from the Facilities to check the condition and cleanliness of the Facilities to be used by the Group. The Group agrees to leave the Facilities in the same condition found at arrival and to reimburse Friends of Camp Wassatoga for all costs of repair or cleaning of the Facilities as a result of the Group's use of the Facilities.
- Cleaning costs for unfinished cleaning will be billed at \$50 per hour. Group agrees to clean any and all facilities used by the group, including and not limited to group activity buildings, lodges/cabins, bathrooms and common areas. There is a \$50 fee for late check out.

Friends of Camp Wassatoga Use Agreement and Liability Waiver Insurance

- The Group agrees to provide a certificate from an insurance carrier in form and substance and from a carrier reasonably acceptable to Friends of Camp Wassatoga 30 days prior to the Group Arrival Date stated on the Group Rental Application stating that the Group is insured under a comprehensive general liability policy with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence \$2,000,000 per aggregate. Friends of Camp Wassatoga must be named as an additional insured on such policy of insurance. In addition, a copy of the endorsement shall be provided. Receipt of the foregoing is a condition to the Group's use of the Facilities.

- Non-compliance will immediately void rental application and forfeit any deposit funds paid. Friends of Camp Wassatoga Rental Agreement & Liability Waiver Assumption of Risk, Indemnification and Hold Harmless, Waiver, Release.
- The Group, each Group Member, and each Permissive User assumes all risks of loss, damage, or injury to persons or property which arise out of the Group's, each Group Member's, or each Permissive User's use of Friends of Camp Wassatoga and the Facilities (including, without limitation, equipment) and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Friends of Camp Wassatoga and its officers, employees, directors, volunteers, representatives, and agents (collectively "Indemnities") from and against any and all judgments, losses, expenses, liabilities, damages, claims, liens and expenses, including but not limited to attorney's fees (at trial, on appeal, and otherwise) which indemnities may suffer, incur, or sustain, as a result of or arising from or connected with any operations, activities, or use of Friends of Camp Wassatoga and the facilities and equipment (including any and all equipment brought for use at Camp Wassatoga or the waters of and property surrounding Lake Sara) by the Group, each Group Member, each Permissive User, and any of the Group's officers, directors, employees, agents, and subcontractors, or any other representatives (collectively "Claims").
- The Group, each Group Member, each Permissive User, and each of the Group's officers, directors, employees, agents, subcontractors, and other representatives hereby waive any and all known and unknown Claims it has or may have against Friends of Camp Wassatoga and hereby releases Friends of Camp Wassatoga from any and all judgments, losses, expenses, liabilities, damages, claims, liens, and expenses which Friends of Camp Wassatoga may suffer, incur, or sustain, as a result of or arising from or connected with any operations or activities, or use by user of Friends of Camp Wassatoga and the facilities and equipment by the Group, each Group Member, each Permissive User, and any of the Group's officers, directors, employees, agents, subcontractors, or other representatives.

- The Group agrees that it is responsible for all persons using the Facilities under this agreement (including, without limitation, Permissive Users) and for the breach of any provision of this agreement.

Attorney Fees

In any arbitration or litigation concerning or arising out of this agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover all expenses of arbitration or litigation including, without limitation, reasonable attorney fees at arbitration, at trial, on any appeal or petition for review. In addition, Friends of Camp Wassatoga is entitled to recover any attorney's fees or costs incurred in connection with collecting any amounts owed by the Group hereunder whether or not litigation is initiated.
